The vendor may be liable for any additional costs incurred by the auctioneers in satisfying the purchaser's requirements.

### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

All Heifers are sold as being under 30 months old and sold with the appropriate passports unless otherwise declared.

### **NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS**

If you are purchasing animals on another person's behalf, you must inform the auctioneer BEFORE the sale commences and it must be agreed with the auctioneers who the animal will go to, and who will pay for them.

We would remind you of the Conditions of Sale that place responsibility for payment on the person bidding if he has not disclosed to the auctioneers the eventual purchaser.

### **NOTES TO VENDORS**

1) The yard will be open from 7.00am to receive stock. Please take advantage of this fact to help booking in and to enable potential purchasers to view prior to sale.

2) **VERY URGENT**

As regards Store Lambs, we would urge vendors to use the EID Slaughter Derogation Tags. These have a flock number that is visual, but an electronic individual number. This will mean your stock will be open for competition from the widest possible company of buyers, It will mean batches can be traced by fatteners without reading tags when they sell finished lambs in big groups. It will mean with Ewe Lambs, they can be retained as Ewes and be upgraded to full EID if the purchaser wishes.

You can use one such tag. We can easily record the numbers and are now registered as a Central Recording Point and will record and give you the information you require for cross compliance amongst other things at no further charge. We will not be able to read lots of mixed flock numbers when fattening lambs come back to us if you just use the cheap manual read tags. Do not use old tags from last year in your lambs. These are illegal. You will be stirring up trouble for yourself.

The Slaughter EID tag costs from our suppliers 71p. To use the sheep manual tag is about 15p. The difference is less than the levy on fat lambs but the cost to you could be much more once purchasers have realized the time and cost of trying to deal with large numbers of manually read tags. **It is a no brainer. If you sell store lambs use the EID option please.**
